CHARTER FOR THE
MARITIME PREPOSITIONING FORCE
PROGRAM OVERSIGHT WORKING GROUP

BACKGROUND: The Maritime Prepositioning Force (MPF) program is a combined Navy and Marine Corps afloat prepositioning program established to support the global positioning of MAGTF equipment and supplies in three interoperable Marine Expeditionary Brigade (MEB) sets placed strategically around the world. The MPF program requires an over-arching Navy and Marine Corps oversight working group that collectively addresses the programmatic aspects of service policy and procedures that impact the operational capability of MPF in support of the combatant commander.


MISSION: The MPF Program Oversight Working Group (POWG) will discuss, review, coordinate, and integrate Navy and Marine Corps issues that impact the current and future MPF program. Advise Navy and Marine Corps leadership on policy and resources required to address program deficiencies. Develop plans of actions and milestones to implement changes in policy, programs, and procedures, and monitor overall program development.


OBJECTIVE: The MPF POWG ensures the effective integration of the MPF program to position the most effective operational mix of assets aboard MPS.


SCOPE: The MPF-POWG is established under the cognizance of Deputy Commandant, Plans, Policies and Operations (DC, PP&O), in coordination with the Deputy Chief of Naval Operations, Warfare Requirements and Programs (DCNO, N75), Deputy Commandant for Logistics (DC, I&L), and Deputy Chief of Naval Fleet Readiness and Logistics, (DCNO, N42). The MPF-POWG is a forum for sharing information and incorporating decisions from other working groups that impact MPF. This forum will facilitate the open discussion of issues across the spectrum of the MPF program from current acquisitions, fielding, readiness, and operations, to future ship developments, transition plans, and marketing strategies.


The MPF-POWG will meet once a quarter, or more often as required, to review pending issues and address new issues for information and follow-on actions. The MPF-POWG will maintain a chronological history of old issues, completed actions, and pending actions. The MPF-POWG will leverage the collective expertise of members to develop courses of action, implement policy decisions, and maintain the MPF program on a steady course. A O-6 level POWG will meet as required.

MEMBERSHIP: MPF program sponsors from HQMC and OPNAV staffs will chair the MPF-POWG. Designated representatives and supporting members are delineated in the attached program sponsorship matrix.
